

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-73

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALIMESA ELECTING TO BECOME SUBJECT TO THE UNIFORM PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION COST ACCOUNTING ACT

WHEREAS, California Public Contract Code Section 20162 requires cities to competitively bid public projects in excess of \$5,000 in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Public Contract Code, commencing with Section 20160; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (the “Act”), California Public Contract Code Section 22000, *et seq.*, in conjunction with the State Controller, has established uniform cost accounting standards and an alternative method for the bidding of public works projects by public agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Calimesa to be subject to the provisions of the Act due to the availability of alternative bidding procedures for public works projects. The benefits to the City include, but are not limited to, allowing public projects of \$60,000 or less to be performed by city employees by force account, by negotiated contract, or by purchase order, and to let contracts by informal bidding procedures for public projects costing up to and including \$200,000 (as such dollar amounts may be revised from time to time); and

WHEREAS, California Public Contract Code Sections 22003 and 22030 provides that any city that wishes to utilize the alternative procedures for bidding and contracting for public projects must elect, by resolution, to become subject to the uniform construction cost accounting procedures set forth in the Public Contract Code and must notify the State Controller of its election; and

WHEREAS, California Public Contract Code Section 22034 requires each public agency that elects to become subject to the uniform construction cost accounting procedures to enact an informal bidding ordinance that complies with the requirements set forth in Section 22034; and

WHEREAS, concurrently herewith, the City Council has introduced an Ordinance, which enacts procedures governing public works contracts and establishes, among other things, informal bidding procedures in accordance with the requirements of Section 22034 of the Public Contract Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALIMESA HEREBY FINDS AND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The City Council finds that all of the facts set forth in the foregoing Recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. Pursuant to the authority set forth in the Act, the City of Calimesa hereby elects to be subject to the uniform public construction cost accounting procedures set forth in the Act and to the policies and procedures manual and cost accounting review procedures established by the California Uniform Construction Cost Accounting Commission, as each may be amended from time to time.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to notify the State Controller of the City's election pursuant to Section 2, above.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption.


