



POOL ABANDONMENT AND BACKFILLING

- 1) A pool demolition permit shall be obtained, submit a detailed site plan indicating pool dimensions and location of the pool.
- 2) An initial inspection shall be requested after complete removal of the pool and all associated components. This shall be prior to the commencement of backfilling.
- 3) All electrical equipment shall be disconnected, and electrical connections terminated in an approved manner. Electrical conductors supplying underwater light fixtures, recirculation pumps, air blowers and other pool equipment shall be removed and terminated in a listed and approved junction box, or at the panel board.
- 4) All-natural gas and water lines shall be properly abandoned and capped off.
- 5) The entirety of the concrete, rebar, conduits, piping, coping and any other associated swimming pool items shall be removed and properly disposed of.
- 6) The pool shall be backfilled with clean soil and compacted every 12 inches or as directed by a soils engineer.
- 7) A compaction report prepared by a licensed soils engineer shall be obtained and presented to the city inspector at the final inspection.
